Central to the life of a Catholic Christian is service offered to others in the name of Jesus Christ. In preparing to be fully initiated in to the Catholic Christian community of Immaculate Conception Church, young people should show by the service they offer to others that they are embracing and committed to following The Way of Jesus. Choosing a service commitment:
In discussion, prayer and discernment with his/her family, the young person will make a special commitment to offer particular service to an individual, organization or group in the name of Jesus Christ. Choose your service commitment in three areas: Home, Parish, and Community. Over the course of the next year, there will be several organized activities from which you may choose. However, when you choose a service commitment, also be mindful of the gifts you possess and the mission of every disciple to be good stewards of their time and talent, recognizing that Christ is in our midst in our brothers and sisters. It is suggested that the candidate keep a journal to record how this service is affecting him/her, and how it is helping whomever the receiver may be, and especially to reflect on the experience following Confirmation. The young person will submit this form, signed by him/her and a parent.
